We are continuing to make progress on our move to 500 East Main Street in Norfolk, and we expect to relocate sometime after September 1. We closed on the sale of our current headquarters at 420 Bank Street in Norfolk in early June, and will rent the building from The Hurrah Players until our move. Additionally, we are finalizing meeting locations in each of the five Southside cities – stay tuned for the official announcement. We are also marketing the sale of our Chesapeake location at 400 Volvo Parkway and have been receiving interest on the building.

A team of Chamber staff members has been meeting regularly to address the operational issues surrounding our new centralized location. We are focusing on how we will continue providing top-level service to our members located throughout Hampton Roads. These issues will be reported to the Chamber's Local Presence Task Force, chaired by Susan Blackman (Willcox & Savage).

Did you know that you can apply for Social Security retirement benefits online? Not sure whether you're ready for retirement? The Social Security Administration (SSA) can help you plan ahead with online benefit planners, including the online Retirement Estimator. This Estimator provides get quick and accurate estimates of retirement benefits based on different scenarios. And you can apply for disability benefits online. You even can apply for help to pay the costs of the Medicare prescription drug program.

Information on retirement, survivors, disability, Supplemental Security Income, and Medicare are easily accessible on Social Security's homepage. But the website offers much more. The site allows you to discover the wider Social Security program.

First, familiarize yourself with their publications, which explain all of SSA's programs. One of their newest publications is a fact sheet that explains the new retirement estimator — found at the Forms and Publications link from the homepage. There, you'll find publications on all the relevant subjects including information about Social Security cards, Social Security numbers, and how Social Security affects women. Moreover, dozens of publications are available in 15 languages.

Chamber Unveils New Networking Program
